The rest of the family, okay. Once you woke up, what happened next?

Interviewee:

We were waiting for everybody.

Interviewer:

Okay. You said we were waiting. Who else was waiting with you?

Interviewee:

Nobody.

Interviewer:

No, it was just you by yourself. Okay. So, what happened next after everyone

woke up?

Interviewee:

We ate.

Interviewer:

Okay, tell me about eating this morning.

Interviewee:

We had cereal. Me too. \_\_\_\_\_ [00:02:01].

Interviewer:

Okay, so you had cereal. Tell me about what the cereal tasted like.

Interviewee:

Candy.

Interviewer:

Candy okay. What did it look like?

Interviewee:

Like a rainbow.

Interviewer:

A rainbow, okay. After you ate your cereal, what did you do next?

Interviewee:

Next we did – we went somewhere.

Interviewer:

You did what? Tell me again.

Interviewee:

We went somewhere.

Interviewer:

Oh, you went somewhere. Tell me about going somewhere. Tell me where you

went. [00:03:00] Who all went?

Interviewee:

Me and my friend.

Interviewer:

You and your friend?

Interviewee:

It was just us two.

Interviewer:

Okay, it was just you and the other friend.

Interviewee:

Hey, this is new.

Interviewer:

Yeah, you can use that to write up here. It probably does not write very long up there, but you can write it on here. Do you want to write your name on that

drawing? What did you do when you left?

Interviewee:

Huh?

Interviewer:

What did you do when you left?

Interviewee:

We went to somewhere.

Interviewer:

Okay. What did you do there when you go there?

Interviewee:

We went in and we played.

Interviewer:

Okay, tell me about playing.

Interviewee:

I am itchy.

Interviewer:

Okay, you are itchy. All right. Clayton, today while you and I are talking just like last time, if I ask you something and you do not know the answer it is okay for you to tell me you do not know. Okay?

Interviewee:

Okay.

Interviewer:

If you do not remember something, you can also let me know that you do not remember. Or if I get something wrong, you can tell me. Sometimes I do not get things right, so you can correct me. Okay?

Okay.

Interviewer:

You can tell me to get things right. The other thing, Clayton, is that today we also have to tell the truth. Okay?

Okay.

Will you promise to tell me the truth? All right, we also have to talk about things that really happened and only things that are real. Okay? You told me about that you are with a new family, but you are not in their family. Okay?

Interviewee:

Okay.

Interviewer:

Last time that you were here, we talked about a lot of different things.

Interviewee:

Like privates?

Interviewer:

Yes, we talked about privates. We talked about family and body parts, yeah. What else?

Interviewee:

And my baby.

Interviewer:

And your baby, that is right. Elijah.

Interviewee:

And our families.

Interviewer:

And the families.

Interviewee:

And all of the families.

Interviewer:

Yes. Yes. We talked about private parts. Was there anything that you were not able to tell me about private parts?

Interviewee:

You cannot touch anybody's privates or touch their eye.

Interviewer:

You cannot touch anybody's privates or their eyes. Okay.

Interviewee:

Yeah, do not kick somebody in the eye.

Interviewer:

Okay.

Interviewee:

They will bleed, and their eye will go in and come out of your mouth.

Interviewer:

Okay. Has someone touched your eye?

Interviewee:

No.

Interviewer:

No? Okay.

Interviewee:

Only, eye doctors do that.

Interviewer:

Only what?

Interviewee:

Eye doctors.

Interviewer:

Only eye doctors do that, okay.

Interviewee:

Yeah.

Interviewer:

Has someone ever hurt your eye? No? How about your body? Has someone hurt

your body? Yeah? Tell [00:06:00] me about that.

Interviewee:

Last time, \_\_\_\_ [00:06:02], I mean at their house.

Interviewer:

Yeah.

Interviewee:

Not in my family. It was in the house.

Interviewer:

At the house? At your family or the family that you are at now?

Interviewee:

The family I am at now.

Interviewer:

Okay. Tell me who was all there at the family that you have now.

Interviewee:

I do not remember their names.

Interviewer:

Okay, and that is all right if you do not remember.

Interviewee:

But they have four kids.

Interviewer:

They have four kids. Do they have a mom and a dad?

Interviewee:

Yeah.

Interviewer:

Okay, so they have four kids. I am going to put the four kids here, but we do not

know their names. Are they boys or girls?

Interviewee:

Boys and girls.

Interviewer:

There is a boy and then a girl.

Interviewee:

Interviewer:

And then there is the parents - mom and a dad. Then how about the other two?

Interviewee:

Boys and girls.

There are two boys and two girls?

Yeah, but he is little.

Interviewer:

He is little. Is he a little boy?

Okay, so there is a little boy. How about the other kid? We have a boy and a girl.

Interviewee:

Interviewer:

Okay.

Just like us.

Interviewer:

Yeah, she talked about body parts just like us. Okay. Were you able to tell her

something about body parts that you were not able to tell me?

Interviewee:

My dad touched my privates.

Interviewer:

Okay. Your dad touched your privates?

Interviewee:

Yeah, but....

Interviewer:

Who is your dad that touched your privates?

Interviewee:

My dad.

Interviewer:

Your dad? What is your dad's name? What is your dad's name that touched

your privates?

Interviewee:

Papa.

Interviewer:

Papa. Tell me everything about Papa touching your privates.

Interviewee:

[00:09:00] Because we were. Dad was taking a bath, but he was not.

Interviewer:

He what now?

Interviewee:

We were taking a bath, but I was not.

Interviewer:

He was taking? You all were taking a bath, but you were not taking a bath?

Interviewee:

No, I was not.

Interviewer:

You were not. Okay.

Interviewee:

How do you make yellow?

Interviewer:

What?

Interviewee:

How do you make yellow?

How do you make yellow? I am not really sure. Tell me. You said that Papa

touched your privates.

His hands.

Him hands?
